IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION

Please take a moment to thoroughly read our new 2017 textbook procedures below.

NEW LOCATION TO DROP OFF AND PICK UP TEXTBOOKS:
North Scituate Elementary School; 46 Institute Lane, North Scituate
Books and/or orders will not be accepted at the Superintendent's Office.

Textbooks borrowed for the 2016-2017 school year must be returned to North Scituate Elementary School **Monday, June 26, 2017, Tuesday, June 27, 2017 or Wednesday, June 28, 2017 between the hours of 9:30 AM and 12:30 PM.** Textbook orders for the following year must be placed during this time also.

2017-2018 orders will be available for pick up **Monday, August 7, 2017; Tuesday, August 8, 2017; and Friday, August 11, 2017** at North Scituate Elementary School between the hours of **9:30 AM and 12:30 PM.**

Please note: No one will be available to process book orders at North Scituate Elementary School at any time other than those listed above.

The order must include all of the following:

- book title
- publisher
- copyright date
- ISBN (10 or 13 digit)
- student's name
- address
- telephone number
- school
- grade

Textbook requests that do not have the above information will not be filled.

Please remind your student to use book covers to protect the books. Students may not write, highlight or in any other way damage the textbooks, unless of course they are of a consumable nature, which will be noted when the books are given to the parent. If there is excessive damage to a book, parents will be charged a fee to restore or replace the book.
